

Microsoft Service Pack 2 (SP2) and website navigation...

The security enhancements provided by Microsoft Windows XP Service Pack 2 (SP2) limits the ability to run ActiveX controls through Microsoft Internet Explorer. These controls are useful for navigating websites, including ours. When the page is loaded, Internet explorer will display the Security alert bar (outlined in red)



In order to show the active navigation portion of our site, please click on the information bar and select "Allow Blocked Content..." from the subsequent menu.



After you have completed this, the secondary navigation that relies on the ActiveX script should function and navigation will become much easier.
