Voter Survey 2004: Summary of Results

In 2004, the Broad Coalition conducted a street survey of over 540 voters in Victoria, Vancouver, Sunshine Coast and various other locations in BC.

Voters were asked a number of questions about cooperation between the Green Party and the NDP in the next provincial election.

Question A: Do you think the Greens and NDP should cooperate by agreeing to run either an NDP or a Green candidate in your constituency for the next election?

Voters Surveyed	Agree: Greens and NDP should cooperate
Supporters of all parties including undecided	57% (518)
NDP supporters	68% (170)
Green Party supporters	76% (66)

Question B: If the NDP and the Green Party agreed that only one candidate, either a Green or an NDP would run in your constituency, would you support either an NDP or Green candidate?

Voters Surveyed	Agree: would support either Green or NDP candidate
Supporters of all parties including undecided	68% (449)
NDP supporters	81% (161)
Green Party supporters	88% (58)

The survey results from Victoria - Beacon Hill and Powell River - Sunshine Coast, the constituencies of the NDP and Green Party leaders, showed results similar to the total sample.
