CADBORO BAY VILLAGE CORE TO GET A FACE LIFT

Through the efforts of the Business Improvement Association and Saanich Engineering there are big plans over the next five years to improve the ambience of Cadboro Bay Village. Starting this summer, the first phase of the improvements will begin with placement of cross-walks at the north and east junctions of Penrhyn and Cadboro Bay Road. The side walks will be enlarged at the junctions to improve

foot access and stop signs erected at the "Starbucks" corner for traffic control and pedestrian safety. Landscaping and planters will also be added.

Over the next few years the parking configuration will change, with parallel parking along both sides of Cadboro Bay Road. The effects will be to narrow Cadboro Bay Road in the village core area, while providing better foot access to the merchants on the

upper side of the Village, with the added benefit of calming traffic.

The Resident's Association thank Councillor Judy Brownoff and all the merchants for their continuing hard work to make our village a truly unique and special place.
